

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Game: Skating (Boys & Girls)

- 1. The championship will be held according to the RSFI (9RR) rules & regulations, with modification wherever applicable.
- 2. The championship will be held in U-14, U-17 & U-19 years age category for boys & girls.
- 3. From each school only one participant can participate in each event.
- 4. A skater can take part in maximum two events in her/his age group.
- 5. A skater can take part either in Quads or in In-line events.
- 6. From each Zone, in each event, separately in Girls' & Boys' in different age categories, the first & second position winners will qualify to participate in the Nationals.
- 7. The skater taking part in Quads should wear the skates that should not have heels attached to the shoe & should not be high ankle.

- 8. The skating costume should be skin tight.
- 9. Helmet is compulsory.
- 10. The wheels for speed skating is only to be used which are broader in size.
- 11. The decision of the technical committee/referee shall be final.
- 12. Any photograph/video clipping other than from official camera shall not be considered for any reference.
- 13. No protest will be entertained from parents.
- 14. Protest if any, has to be submitted in writing by the designated team Coach/Manager, in writing, to the Chief Referee, within 15 min of the announcement of result. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.
- 15. The schools Organizing Cluster/Zonal level meet shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate in Zonal / National level meet. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
