

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

# Game : Archery (Girls & Boys)

- 1. The Archery competition will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Archery Championship with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. The competition will be held in the following three categories in U-14, U-17 & U-19 years age separately for boys and girls groups.
  - The competition will be held for :

- (a) Team Championship
  - (b) Individual Championship : The school that would be participating in team championship can sponsor one player from its team for participating in individual Championship.
  - (c) The nomination of Individual player shall be done at the time of registration. No other player will be entertained on the place of nominated player. In that case the player and the team will be disqualified for the game.
    - \* School/Player can participate directly individual Championship (even if there team is not participating in the competition)
- 4. There are three types events which are Indian, Recurve & Compound Round .
- 5. A team shall consist of maximum of four players.
- 6. A school can enter only one team in each category. Meaning a School can enter one team each in Indian Round, Recurve & Compound separately for boys and girls.
- 7. The competition will be held outdoors.
- 8. The decision of the Referees/Judges shall stand final and cannot be challenged.
- 9. In each category, the position/medal winners would be decided on the basis of "Ranking Event" (with no elimination round).
- 10. All players must carry their on personal equipments including Bow, Arrows & Accessories.
- 11. The school Organizing Cluster/Zonal level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at Zonal/National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Proforma.
