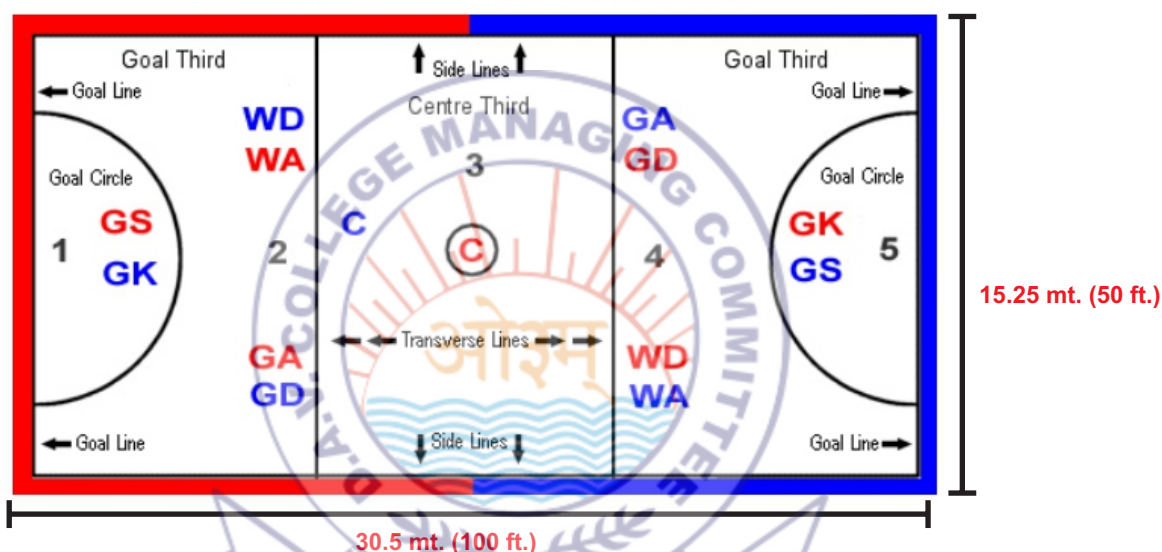


RULES AND REGULATIONS

Game : Netball (Girls & Boys)

1. The tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Netball Federation of India with modifications wherever applicable.
2. The championship will be held in U-14, U-17 & U-19 years age category for boys & girls.
3. A netball team consists of up to 12 players with 7 players allowed on court at any one time. A team may take the court with a minimum of 5 players.

Playing positions & court areas

Position	Responsibilities	Court Area
GS	To score goals and to work in and around the circle with the GA	1 & 2
GA	To feed and work with GS and to score goals	1, 2 & 3
WA	To feed the circle players giving them shooting opportunities	2 & 3
C	To take the Centre Pass and to link the defence and the attack	2, 3 & 4
WD	To look for interceptions and to prevent the WA from feeding the circle	3 & 4
GD	To win the ball and reduce the effectiveness of the GA	3, 4 & 5
GK	To work with the GD and to prevent the GS from scoring goals	4 & 5

4. A game consists of 4 x 15 minute quarters with an interval of 3 minutes between the first, second, third and fourth quarters and a 5 minute half time interval. There is up to 2 minutes of time allowed for each injury..
5. The First position winning teams from each Cluster will qualify to participate in Zonal level tournament.

6. In any match, played on knock out basis including the final, if there is a tie, extension of five minutes shall continue to be given till the game is decided.
7. The number “5” size Ball will be used for Boys' & Girls' matches.
8. A team shall be prepared to play more than two matches in a day.
9. All participating teams shall carry with them two sets of playing kit (uniform), one set of light color and the other set of dark color.
10. All the matches at Cluster/Zonal/National level shall be conducted on knock out basis.
11. The First position winning teams from each Cluster will qualify to participate in Zonal level tournament.
12. Protest if any, must be submitted in writing along with the fee within 20 min after the declaration of the result.
13. In case a team intends to protest against the opposite team; the Captain of team that intends to protest, must sign the score sheet.
14. The school Organizing Cluster/Zonal level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at Zonal/National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Performa.
